Experience live performance in front of an audience, prepare and produce a short film, work in animation, prepare materials and artefacts for a visual arts exhibition - experience all of this and much more on the **Higher Diploma in Creative and Media**.

Whilst studying for the Diploma, you may:

- Use your creative skills and ideas to make something
- Learn how to work up ideas, alone and in a team
- Learn about the work of other artists and how it relates to your own work
- Explore different creative disciplines
- Find out what you're passionate about: from music to drama, film to textiles, 3D visual art to advertising
- See a project through from start to finish
- Identify an audience and their needs, and how this affects your work
- Find out about the business side of a creative project, like budgeting, team working and marketing your ideas and products

To participate in the Diploma, you must be able to work across at least two of these three broad areas: Performing Arts, Media, Visual Arts. You will work with employers both locally and across the region, and will complete 10 days work experience.

The Higher Diploma is equivalent to 7 GCSE Grades A*-C.
