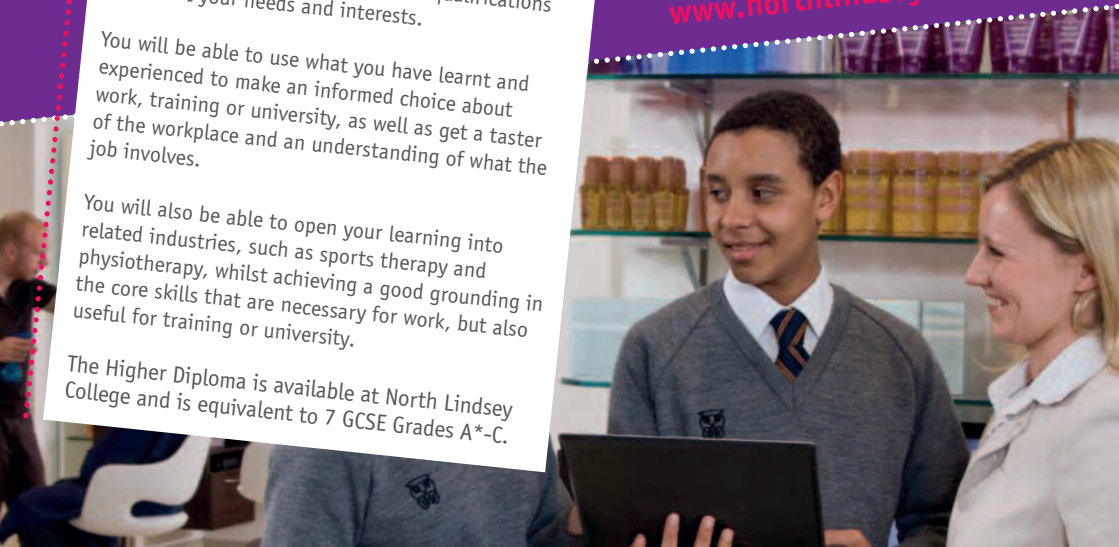
You will be able to use what you have learnt and experienced to make an informed choice about work, training or university, as well as get a taster of the workplace and an understanding of what the job involves.
