

The Higher Diploma in Information Technology

This course is unique as learners attend sessions at both North Lindsey College and John Leggott College. The IT Diploma is a 1 year course that, on successful completion, is broadly equivalent to 7 good GCSEs. This Diploma will focus on the uses of ICT in the working environment.

Diplomas are designed to support progression to further study, training or employment. Learners will have the opportunity to develop skills that employers and universities value.

The Diploma combines theory and classroom learning with practical, hands-on experience. Sessions are mainly delivered in IT rooms where learners will complete projects and assignments that are based on work realistic contexts.

Applications are welcome from learners who have a range of GCSE grades D or above including Maths and English.

This Diploma is available to both pre 16 and post 16 learners.
