It offers you lots of practical experience in dealing with people, and at least 10 days working with an employer. This is a great way to use the skills you have learnt in the classroom and experience what work is like from the inside.

You will produce a student project to demonstrate the skills and knowledge you have gained. This might be a written report or practical activity, like thinking of ways to improve activities for young people in your area.

It will give you the skills you need for College, University or work. It could help you decide on a career as a Nurse, Teacher or Community Support Officer.

The Higher Diploma is available at North Lindsey College to both pre 16 and post 16 learners and is equivalent to 7 GCSE Grades A*-C.
